KS2 Assessments.

Two pupils sat their KS2 English and Maths tests. Despite the tests being challenging, the pupils tried very hard and remained calm. Staff are very proud of the pupils' effort and achievement.

KS1 Assessments

Two pupils sat the English KS1 reading and maths tests during May. Both pupils met the expected standard in reading. One pupil achieved a scaled score of 92 in their maths paper, achieving working towards the expected standard. The other pupil is judged to be working towards the expected standard.

4 pupils in Year 1 took the Phonic Test. One pupil is working at the expected standard and 3 working towards. 6 pupils in Year 2 re-sat the test. One pupil is working at the expected standard and all pupils increased their score from last year.

Pupil Outcomes

- ▶ We are very proud of our pupils' achievements. We believe that the majority of our pupils make outstanding progress whilst in our care; not just academically but also in terms of social and emotional development. All pupils are making good progress towards outcomes on their Education, Health and Care Plans. We set targets for the pupils which take into account their age, need and level of development. All pupils make appropriate and substantial progress from their differing starting points.
Pupil progress judgements are made on an individualised basis. The majority of pupils made good progress across the Key Stage. Where progress was slower, this was due to deterioration in health. Judgements are based on end of Key Stage 1 levels and where the children are working at now, at Y6. As there are no levels anymore, the pupils EHCP targets, Key Stage Standards and Progression levels were used as a guide to their overall attainment.
